Kids Introductory Pottery (10+)

Monday Evening beginning March 30th, April 6, April 20, April 27

This pottery class is an introductory class for children 10yrs and older. Focus will be on learning techniques both on the wheel and hand-building. A maximum of four pots will be bought home. Clean up is an important part of the process, each participant will be responsible for cleaning up. Class size is limited to 8

1 bag of clay and all tools required are included in the cost. Pottery pieces will be ready for pick up 2 weeks after classes are finished.
